



What You Need To Know

Drugs—The primary drug of choice among teens in Temecula is marijuana. According to the 2012-2013 California Healthy Kids Survey 41% of 11th grade male students and 37% of 11th grade female students have admitted to smoking marijuana in their life time.

Human Trafficking—The fastest growing crime in the nation. The second most lucrative crime after guns and drugs. 3 out of 4 California Human Trafficking cases involve U.S. Citizens.

Video Game Addiction—Based on peer reviewed research, 1 in 11 kids are addicted to video games, causing dysfunction in multiple areas of their lives. Kids who play less than 1 hour of age-appropriate video games daily receive benefits from gaming. Kids who play more than 3 hours per day exhibit problems associated with excessive gaming. The Kaiser Foundation reports the average child uses digital screens for entertainment 7 hours 38 minutes daily.

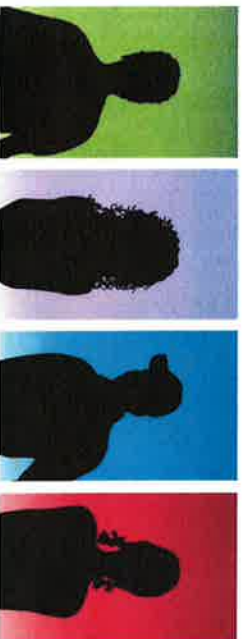
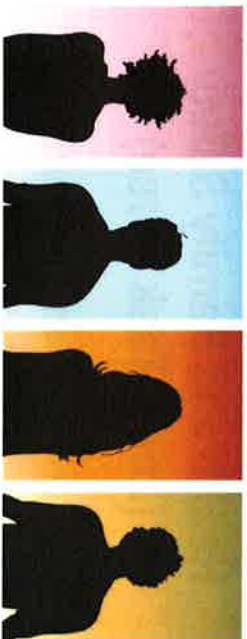
Local Task Force Background
