PROJECT STATUS REPORT

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS IN PROGRESS
(TRIP Report)

1. Interstate 15 and Temecula Parkway

Project: Interstate 15 / State Route 79 South Interchange (Capital Improvement Program (CIP))

Status: Contracted construction work is complete. Caltrans has completed its post-construction project review and requires additional, minor construction adjustments. One-year plant establishment period commenced April 2019. Visit the project web page: <https://1579south.info/> for details on traffic restrictions.

2. Butterfield Stage Road (Between La Serena Way and Rancho Vista Road)

Project: Butterfield Stage Road Expansion

Status: Widening of Butterfield Stage Road to four lanes. Traffic control and lanes closures will vary.

Haul Route through November 18, 2019:

Commencing at southeast corner of Butterfield Stage Road and La Serena Way intersection, north to Murrieta Hot Springs Road, west to I-215, north to Clinton Keith Road (exiting the city limits).

Return Route:

I-15 South to Rancho California Road east to Butterfield Stage Road north to southeast corner of Butterfield Stage Road and La Serena Way intersection.

Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Anticipate completion of project in January 2020.

3. Dendy Parkway (From Diaz Road to Winchester Road)

Project: Recycled Water Line

Status: EMWD installing recycled water line. Work hours are variable Monday through Friday. Project is anticipated to be completed in September 2019.

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4. Diaz Road and Rancho California Road

Project: Water Line Installation

Status: EMWD installing force main line on Diaz Road. Intermittent traffic control through September 2019.

5. Jedediah Smith Road (Between Cabrillo Avenue and Calle De Velardo)

Project: Pechanga Parkway Mitigation

Status: Shoulder work with intermittent lane closures through the end of September 2019. Work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Anticipate completion in September 2019.

6. La Paz Street and Ynez Road (Between Vallejo Avenue and Ynez Road)

Project: Roundabout Improvements on Ynez Road

Status: La Paz Road is closed between Vallejo Avenue and Ynez Road. Ynez Road will have narrowed lanes with reduced speed limits. Anticipate completion in October 2019.

7. Loma Linda Road and Temecula Lane (Off Pechanga Parkway)

Project: Rancho Soleo Housing Development

Status: Waterline tie-in. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Anticipate completion in September 2019.

8. Margarita Road and De Portola Road

Project: Margarita Office Building

Status: Gas and water line installation. Traffic signals will be on flash and there will be various traffic control on westbound and eastbound DePortola Road. Work hours are 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Anticipate completion in September 2019.

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9. Mercedes Street and Sixth Street (Up to Mary Phillips Senior Center)

Project: Sixth Street Sidewalk Improvements

Status: Work to stain sidewalks. Works hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Anticipation completion in September 2019.

10. Murrieta Hot Springs Road and Butterfield Stage Road

Project: Sommers Bend

Status: EMWD installing water line. Various lane closures on westbound Murrieta Hot Springs Road through September 2019. Work hours are 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

11. Old Town (Various Locations)

Project: Old Town Boardwalk Enhancement

Status: Remove wooden boardwalk planks and replace with enhanced "wood look" stamped concrete. Work hours are Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Anticipate completion by the end of December 2019.

12. Pauba Road

Project: Library Parking Lot

Status: Construction of new parking lot, modified entry/exit and new book drop. No lane closures scheduled at this time.

Haul Route – through August 14, 2019 commencing at export site, Butterfield Stage Road north to La Serena Way west to Margarita Road south to Pauba Road west, right into site directly West of Temecula Public Library parking lot.

Return Route - Exit import site left going west on Pauba Road to Ynez Road, north to Rancho California Road, east to Butterfield Stage Road north, right into site.

Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Anticipate project completion in November 2019.

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13. Pechanga Parkway (Between Via Gilberto and Wolf Creek Drive South)

Project: Pechanga Parkway Widening

Status: Work to widen Pechanga Parkway. Northbound lanes narrowed and speed reduced to 35 mph. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Sunday through Thursday, 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (as needed) through September 2019.

14. Pechanga Parkway (Between Rainbow Canyon Blvd. and Muirfield Drive)

Project: Mexico Cafe

Status: Installation of sewer, storm drain and power. Northbound alternate lane closures. Work hours are 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. beginning August 11, 2019. Anticipate completion by the end of September 2019.

15. Rancho California Road (Between Moraga Road and Cosmic/Humber Drive)

Project: Temecula Village

Status: Sewer line tie-in and base paving. Intermittent east and westbound lane closures. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Anticipate completion by the end of September 2019.

16. Remington Avenue

Project: Water Line Tie-In

Status: Eastern Municipal Water District water line tie-in with various lane closures. Work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Anticipate completion in September 2019.

17. Winchester Road and Nicolas Road

Project: Woodside Homes

Status: Road improvements at the Winchester Road and Nicolas Road intersection. Pedestrians will not be able to cross Winchester Road from the crosswalk by the ARCO station. The crosswalk will be closed. Pedestrians can cross Winchester from the RITE-AID parking lot. There will be a new temporary crosswalk on Nicolas Road with a crossing guard. Work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through March 2020. All businesses will remain open during construction.
